Inasmuch as the **Class of 1979** published a yearbook, loaned to me courtesy of Cleatus Davis and his mother, Marie Davis Vinson, this writer has had a much easier time learning the history of this class. The "annual" is black with a ferocious crouching colored Tiger on the cover. The book titled, "Tiger '79", opens with a good picture of the "new high school", which opened in 1963, with flags flying high above the entryway. The Editor of the Annual Staff was Kyle Clayton and Co-Editor was Patrick Struck; the Advisor was Sharon Horton. The "annual" has a clear and effective Foreword followed by an easy to read Table of Contents. The book was dedicated to Mr. Don Sparks, "teacher and friend" and also a capable photographer it appears. Seventh grade students through the seniors are identified in the book. **Note:** A neat feature of this book is the publication of the Class Composite "Mangum 9th Grade 1978-79" on page 129. This lends even more history when searching for 'lost' classmates.

A memoriam appears at the end of the book: Lonzo Cody, August 13, 1961 – July 3, 1979. This memoriam appeared to have been the last tribute the publishers could do for a fallen classmate.

According to the Mangum Star-News, May 17, 1979, the Mangum High School Alumni Association Banquet and activities were well attended when 530 grads poured into Mangum. President that year was Mary Jane McDaniel Looper; Vice-President was Nedra Wilson Garrett; Secretary was Sue Petzold Dudek; Treasurer was LaVerne Wallace Lanford; Assistant Secretary was Sonya Griffis Patton and Kay Morgan Staton was the Historian. The theme was "Disco Mania". The Class of 1954 won the attendance award with 58% present. Three ladies were pictured on the cover of the Mangum Star from the class of 1929. Ila Banks Harris, Altus; Pauline Briley Lancaster, Ponca City, OK, and LaFon Banks, Mangum. They were celebrating their 50th reunion.
