Again, we are honoring our "National Treasures" of the Mangum High School Alumni Association. They have left big foot prints for us to follow.

The most senior Alumnus of the MHS Association, from the 1932 class, is Helen Wickersham Butterfield, who turned 103 on March 8, 2017. She has decided to not make the trip this year since there is no one to accompany her on the plane from Florida.

In the 1934 class, we have one classmate living that we are aware of: Juanita Barnes-Pitts, of California. Her daughter keeps us abreast of her mom. She turned 102 in January 2017.

The Class of 1935, we know, has a living classmate: Olga Shadid Hawkins of Altus.

The class of 1936 has a classmate, Rhonda Francis Short of Midwest City, who still corresponds with this Historian the old fashioned way: U. S. mail.

The class of 1937 has Ruth Dodson St Onge living in Mississippi. She is 97 and has sent her dues for 2017. She thrilled this Historian when she corresponded by U. S. mail. On March 28, 2017, Ruth called to talk history and is sending me history. Her father did his medical practice in Willow, OK. He was a MHS 1900 grad and had to go elsewhere to get his 12th year of schooling and begin his medical studies. Mangum, Texas, only had 11 years of schooling. I learned she is a cousin to Sharon Phipps and the late Doris Underwood Uechart, of Willow, who lived to be 104. Ruth attended Mangum HS two years and had WONDERFUL teachers. She remembers Miss Mary Hall and Miss Tommie Johnson. Ruth is a retired teacher.

The classes of 1938 and 1939 have two local classmates living in Mangum: Jim C. Hall, '38. and Joe Head, '39. They were buddies growing up in Mangum, corresponded with each other for 70 years and are both living in Mangum at the present time.

Each year we find another living member through friends or relatives and we try our best to contact that member and/or the family for more information. Below, you will find current information on our oldest alumni members, some of whom have called this historian or family members have let us know their whereabouts. We're sad to learn of the deaths, but closure is better than 'unknown' to the Alumni family.
